Our community has two models but you must replace your mailbox with the exact same model installed by the builder for your home.

We have the [Estate Collection](#) models

ME-1 or ME-3 with a 5" fluted post and red stamped aluminum flag.

The cost for replacement of a single mailbox is \$596, doubles are \$840. Pricing includes installation.
