POOL & PLAYGROUND AMENITIES

- The following guidelines have been put in place to ensure a safe opening of the above mentioned amenities and to ensure the health, safety, and welfare of all residents during use.
- In the event that the guidelines are not followed as listed an immediate closure of all amenities listed will take place until further notice.

CDC Guidelines

- All pool attendees are encouraged to wear face coverings when they are on the pool deck or other areas outside of the water (not advised to wear mask while in water).
- Swimmers are required to stay six feet (6') apart from anyone who they don't live with (while in the pool).

LAKE SAWYER SOUTH (BOARD OF DIRECTORS) GUIDELINES

- Pool capacity not to exceed 50% (50 total residents) for June and July 2020 based on total capacity of 101 (includes on the pool deck or in the water).
- Playground not to exceed groups of ten (10) or more and social distancing (6') of all Adult Residents must be exercised (group combinations of children and adults).
- Pool and playground are restricted to Resident use and their immediate family members (relatives and guests outside of community prohibited) June and July 2020.
- Swimming laps, aquatic / aerobic exercises, and any pool games that would jeopardize social distancing (6') of other residents in the pool is prohibited for June and July 2020.
- Group and family gatherings must remain ten (10) or less in size and have social distancing requirements enforced at a distance of six (6') feet.
- Residents will be required to sanitize tables and chairs after use (with resident provided sanitizing agents).
- Residents may provide their own pool chairs however they must be removed each day (chairs left overnight will be discarded) for June and July 2020.
- Pool toys (including any type of balls) are prohibited for June and July 2020.
- Birthday parties or other celebrations will not be permitted during June and July 2020.
- Residents are encouraged to contact OCSO at 311 for any resident or non-resident that is not adhering to the posted guidelines.
- Residents assume all risks while using the above referenced amenities.
